I am requesting funding for the City of Fayetteville's Locks Creek and Sessoms Drainage Improvements for Stormwater Mitigation project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina located at 433 Hay Street, Fayetteville, North Carolina 28301. The funding would be used to support construction projects related to two key drainage improvements within the city, aimed at mitigating the impact of storm-related flooding, personal injury and property damage during future catastrophic weather events.
