I am pleased to inform you that the Office of Local Defense Community Cooperation has approved a federal grant for \$14,900,000 to the City of Boiling Spring Lakes as part of a larger \$51,845,000 project under the Defense Community Infrastructure Pilot Program. This project supports Military Ocean Terminal Sunny Point by restoring four dams damaged by 2018 Hurricane Florence, reestablishing the safety and security of the dams, and mitigating flood risks to Army operations. The Department appreciates the City of Boiling Spring Lakes' support of Military Ocean Terminal Sunny Point.

Groundbreaking may commence once all environmental requirements have been met. Similar notification letters have been provided to members of the Congressional delegation representing this project.
